There are two powerful observation the Holy Spirit made clear to me that the text presents two theological ideas that's implied in the text, so watch the premise according the text a profane thing was done by that I mean disrespectful thing was somebody planted some bad seed and so the question was posed "Did not thou plant good seed in the field? Then the question is clear who planted that bad seed? And in order to appreciate what we're going to be speaking about I need to take you on a journey through the mind of a gardener and his preparation of the sowing concept.

I."The gardener has to "TOP SOIL" it but that could be problematic" (You top soil is

friendly, it welcomes any and every seed known man, it never discriminatory, it welcome good and bad seed much like the mind so imagine if the mind is like top soil and Satan planted Jealousy, envy and or strife and imagine that, that over grows can you imagine the damage it will do over time? Because eventually it will find root in the heart)
